Speeches

Chris Whitehouse, Chair of the Urology Trade Association and Chairman of the Whitehouse Consultancy, spoke about how the UTA was set up to defend clinical and patient choice, as well as promote and protect the drug tariff. He also discussed the importance of not compromising patient safety when it comes to saving costs for the NHS.

Dave Bracher, Campaign Manager at the Spinal Injuries Association, spoke about his own experiences of being spinal cord injured and the impact this has had on his life.
